**METHODOLOGY**

Sorting, Pick and Pack and loading of Family Planning Commodities and Pictures

**IMPACT**

The commodities were transported from ADSPHCDA Central store to the respective PHC facilities using appropriate logistics arrangements.

Distribution started on 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2026. Upon arrival at each facility, commodities were offloaded, verified, and cross-checked against the distribution lists. Facility in-charges or designated staff confirmed the quantities and condition of the items delivered.

Relevant documentation, including delivery notes was duly completed and signed to ensure transparency, and accountability of the commodities.

**LESSON LEARN**

The distribution exercise was generally smooth and well-coordinated. No major challenges were encountered during transportation or delivery. Facilities were adequately prepared to receive the commodities. Minor logistical delays, where observed, were promptly resolved without affecting the overall outcome of the exercise

**FEEDBACK**

All the beneficiary Health Facilities received their allocated commodities in good condition. The exercise significantly improved the availability of Family Planning commodities at the facility level and enhanced readiness to deliver quality health services to the communities served.

**EXPENDITURE**

The Last Mile Distribution of Family Planning Commodities cost four million three hundred and twenty-nine thousand naira (4,329,000) only

**CHALLENGES ARE:**

Family Planning commodities are inadequate, thus the need for the state Government to invest in FP commodities.

**RECOMMENDATION: -**

The last mile distribution of Family Planning Commodities to the beneficiary Health facilities was successfully completed. It is recommended that:

- Routine last mile distributions be sustained to prevent stock-outs.
- Regular monitoring and supportive supervision to be conducted to ensure proper utilization and stock management.
- Training and re-training of MCH Directors and PHC staff on Contraceptive Logistic Management System (CLMS) be carried out Periodically.
