- ▶ Over 2030 new Cooperative Societies were formed and registered and Over 500 Cooperative Societies were empowered and this has improved their productivity and strengthen their commitments towards contributing to the State economic growth.

- ▶ **Twenty (20) youth were trained on Entrepreneurship Mindset Development While fifteen (15) Artisan Cooperative Societies drawn from five selected insurgency affected LGAs of Gombi, Hong, Mubi North, Mubi South and Maiha were empowered with various equipment and working tools.**
- ▶ **The items distributed include: Sewing Machines, grinding machines, water pumps, Generators, Hand dryers, clippers, carpentry tools, welding machines and many more.**
- ▶ **The objective of the training and empowerment programme was for the various youth and artisan cooperative societies to develop capacities in terms of working tools, skills and entrepreneurship mindset to go into businesses of their own, be self-reliant and employers of labour.**

- ❖ **The platform so far, has registered over 1,900 entrepreneurs in the database showing their business categories, business sector, size, employee, gender of business owner and other relevant information.**

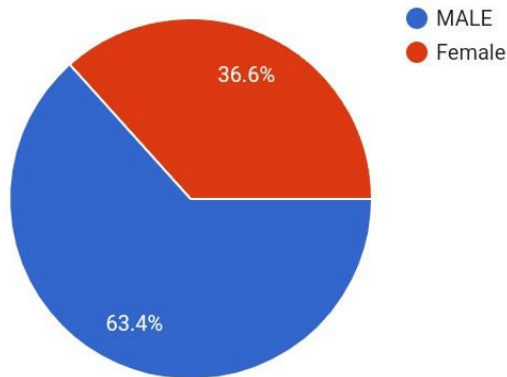

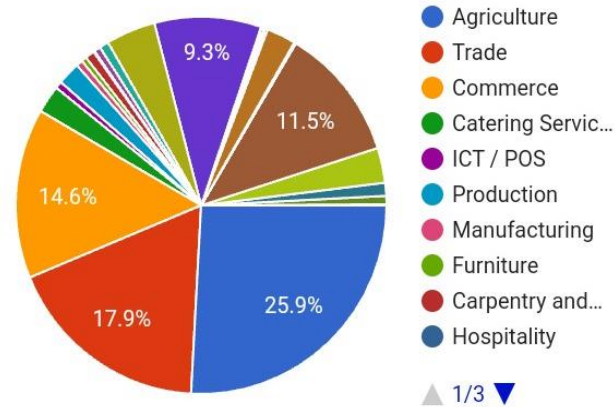

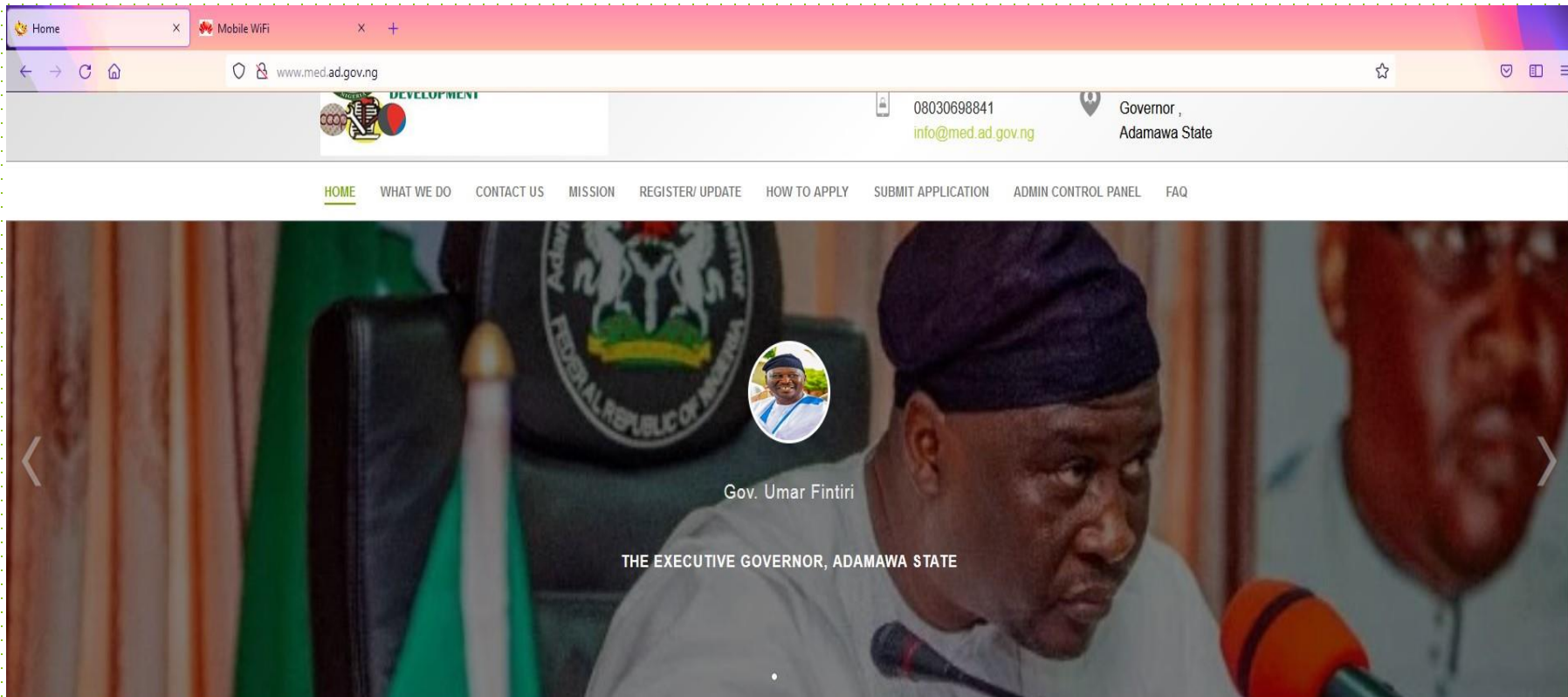
- ▶ Statistics revealed that 63.4% of total entrepreneurs registered are Male and 36.6% are female.
- ▶ It also revealed that 25.9% are from Agricultural sector, 17.9% from trade, 14.6% from commerce, 11.5 from ICT/POS and 9.3 from production sector.

Area of Challenges

The following key challenges are militating against optimal performance of the Ministry:

- ▶ Lack of Utility Vehicle in the Ministry for M&E of Cooperative & Entrepreneurship Activities.
- ▶ Shortage of Office accommodation both at the headquarter and the Area Offices across the 21 LGA.
- ▶ Lack of Entrepreneurship and Industrial Layout for the expansion and easy clustering of entrepreneurs.
- ▶ Inadequate working tools such as computers, tablets, software for effective registration & Mgt of entrepreneurs activities across the 21 LGAs of the State.

Possible Solutions to the Problems

The following suggestions could help to address the identified challenges being faced by the Ministry:

- ▶ Provision of at least one (1) Utility Vehicle to the Ministry.
- ▶ Provision of Office accommodation to the Area Cooperative Offices by the LG Chairmen of the 21 LGAs and Rehabilitation of office blocks at the HQs & Zones.
- ▶ Provision of Land for establishment of Industrial Layout for easy clustering of entrepreneurs/artisans & Provision of Common User Facilities.
- ▶ Provision of necessary working tools for effective registration & Mgt of entrepreneurs activities across the 21 LGAs of the State.

- ▶ The Ministry has continuously enjoyed tremendous support from His Excellency, Rt. Hon Ahmadu Umaru Fintiri especially in the area of **empowerment** through PAWECA;
- ▶ Supported **Skill Development** for youth in the various Technical Skills Training Centers; This has great impact on Social Capital Building & improvement in Human Capital Development Index (HCDI)
- ▶ However, there is need to increase support for the teeming **cooperative groups** and **artisans** who operate at the different communities and are contributing to the rural economy of the State.
